As a teacher her students have won many awards including: Princes Grace Award, Spotlight Award and the National Arts Recognition Award.

Her students work in international and national modern and ballet companies, jazz companies, on Broadway and in the Hollywood industry. They have been accepted into Julliard, NYU, Sony Pictures and many other top programs both in the USA and Europe. She has been on the judging panel for the Fosse Scholarship Awards, Festival Under the Stars in Palm Springs, and the Imagination Celebration of OPAC.

She has received awards for teaching, choreography and producing. Brockus has served on the board of the Dance Resource Center, and Jazz Dance LA Foundation where she was instrumental in helping produce shows for two seasons.

Brockus has a vision for the future of Los Angeles as the next international center for dance and continues to work tirelessly to make that vision a reality.
